IN ETERNAL MEMORY OF OUR DECEASED MEMBERS OF THE ALBANY AHEPA FAMILY

The deceased AHEPANS that we memorialize here today were a vital part of the Order of the American Hellenic Educational Progressive Association (AHEPA), which was founded in Atlanta, Georgia in 1922, for the purpose of assisting immigrants of Greek descent to achieve American citizenship, fluency in the English language, and to facilitate their assimilation into the American Community. From humble roots, the Order of AHEPA has grown to become a respected, world-wide organization whose mission is to promote Hellenism, Education, Philanthropy, Civic Responsibility, and Family and Individual Excellence.

Hellenism

AHEPA is deeply committed to the preservation and promotion of Hellenism, whose principals include a commitment to humanity, freedom, and democracy.

Education

AHEPA's commitment to education is well documented. Over \$4 million is endowed at the local, district and national levels toward the use of scholarships, and another half-million dollars is awarded annually. It's most famous recipient is, perhaps, ABC Good Morning America host, George Stephanopoulos. The AHEPA Educational Foundation administers the scholarship program and also promotes the preservation of Hellenic and Classical Studies programs at universities. Other educational programs such as Journey to Greece are also sponsored by the AHEPA Educational Foundation.

Philanthropy

Philanthropy and volunteerism are pillars of AHEPA. From natural disaster relief, to raising funds for the elimination of life-threatening diseases, to Senior Housing, to making significant contributions to our local neighborhoods, AHEPA is at the forefront of charitable giving and community support.

Civic Responsibility

AHEPA is proactive in communicating the issues and positions of the Greek-American community to elected representatives at the federal, state, and local levels, as well as to our diplomatic leaders. They range from Greece, Cyprus, and Turkey, as well as to others that concern domestic policy affecting philanthropic, civic, and community service based programs.

Family and Individual Excellence

What makes AHEPA unique is the creation of the AHEPA Family. Together with its three affiliated organizations, the AHEPA Family works as a unit and has contributed well over a billion dollars to national and worldwide projects throughout its history.
